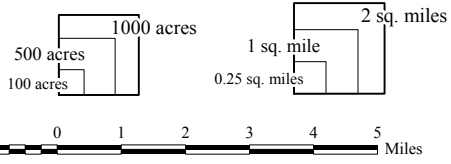
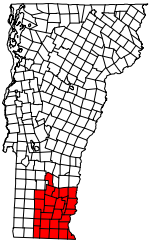


# 2006 Windham Regional Plan

## Public and Conserved Lands

**Publicly-owned land:**

- Federal
- State
- Town

Federal lands include those administered by the Forest Service, Army Corps of Engineers, and Fish and Wildlife Service. State lands include State Forests, State Parks, and Wildlife Management Areas, among others. Town lands are generally town forests or watershed lands. A town may own land in another municipality.

**Land owned by a Conservation Organization:**



This category includes lands owned primarily by The Nature Conservancy, Windmill Hill Pinnacle Association, Putney Mountain Association, and New England Forestry Foundation, among others.

**Privately-owned land with a Conservation Easement:**



Most conservation easements are held by the Vermont Land Trust or the Vermont Housing Conservation Board.
